Tulsa Port of Catoosa:

Did you know that Tulsa has an inland riverport? The Tulsa Port of Catoosa is a multi-modal

shipping complex (Barge, Boats, Rail or Truck) and is one of the largest, most inland riverports in the United States. In 1971 the Tulsa Port of Catoosa and the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas Navigation System opened for operations. After fifty plus years the port employs more than 3,000 people with an average of 82 million tons of freight passed through the port. On the tour we will see John R. Stuart Maritime Park and the Charley Border dry-docked towboat. The Charley Border was the first towboat purchased by the Port Authority. This towboat held a huge role for the port. The towboat spent 27 years switching barges in the 1-3/4 mile channel of the Tulsa Port of Catoosa.

D.W. Correll Museum:

Now let's take a trip down Route 66 and memory lane to D.W. Correll Museum. Here you will explore two (2) buildings with a wide range of interesting collections. You will get to experience a rare and interesting assortment of rocks, gems, fossils and minerals from all around the world. When you think of the past what do you think of? Vintage cars? Yes, me too! The Second building is where you will find the antique automobiles, from toy tractors to a 1902 Oldsmobile Runabout, and an 1898 Locomotive Steam Engine.

by Hugh Davis as a surprise anniversary gift to his wife Zelta, as she collected whale figurines. As we head back to Tulsa we will stop by the fairgrounds and visit the 76-foot-tall Golden Driller. If time allows, we will stop at a souvenir shop to do a little shopping.
